So that we can ensure all eligible children have their raffle tickets included for the bookworms, reading records need to be handed in every Thursday.

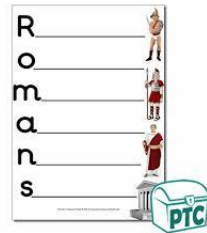
Curriculum project

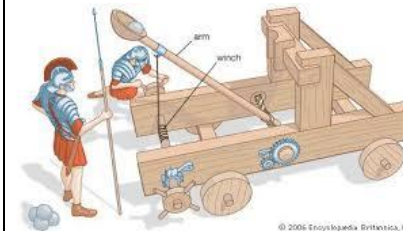
Design and make a Roman mosaic.



Use your learning to create an acrostic poem for the word ROMANS.



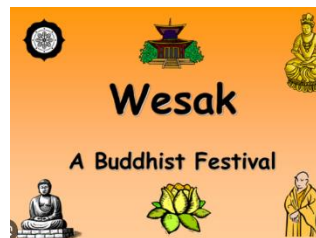
Can you create your own moving product that uses lever and linkage mechanisms?
