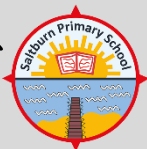

Can you write a poem or song based on the theme of 'belonging'.



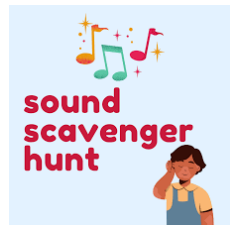
Research a charitable organisation. Can you make a presentation to share about the good work they do?
